A general description of the Proposed Project is as follows: The construction and operation of a 125,000m<sup>3</sup> Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) Storage and Re-gasification Facility (*“LNG Plant”*); a 60 MW natural gas electricity generation facility inclusive of power distribution system from Arawak Cay to the Nassau Cruise Port (*“Power Plant”*) and 1480m<sup>3</sup>/pd reverse osmosis water plant, together facilitating the provision of shore power to cruise ships at the Nassau Cruise Port and the transport and sale of LNG within The Bahamas (*“the Proposed Project”*).
